Trustees Report for the year ending 31st March 2021

General

It's been a good year for the Charity, with a few more regular donors and several surprisingly large spot donations.

The children are now even better fed than last year, and likely more robust with our supply of vitamin supplementation.

At the end of the financial year we estimate that with your help we've provided just under 60.000 simple but nourishing meals, which has hepled the villagers through this dangerous and difficult time, including extra general village feeding during the Covid pandemic.

The Charity's incomes are up, and operating costs have been reduced even further by (from March 2020) using a different means of transferring money, saving about £270 in a full year. In the year 2020 - 2021 money transfer charges amounted to just 0.4% of our expenditure, so we'll be able to do even more next year.

It's been so difficult for the Villagers this year, with COVID 19 concurring with a major irrigation failure, and loss of crops, although the rice harvest was a very good

In conjunction with our sister charity we resolved the irrigation problem via the joint purchase of a new pump, and the gardens can now go back into production.

Health and Nutrition

sustain the feeding load and expand horizons towards improvements in the health situation in the Village, and this has been very successful. We've managed to part fund significant improvements to the Primary Health Care Centre (PHC), which is so important to the Village.

There's a good prospect now of the PHC moving gradually to a higher level of self sufficiency, and that's something we'll be working on over the coming months.




Efficient use of all donations is critically important to us for all the obvious reasons, and the formal results below show a slight improvement on the

delivered to target.

We feel we've "got well on top" of the basic feeding issue. Next year promises to be even a little better than 2020 - 2021, as a small number of new donors have come aboard, and that allows us to look further forward. Early signs for 2021-22 have permitted early growth beyond simple feeding, although we must always keep reserves against donor losses or untoward events.

We're still investigating how best to spend donor money in efficient ways of preventing some disease via vitamin supplementation for nursing mums. This should give the mums better protection and at the same time increasing the likelihood of the children being born with healthier immune
